RE: ClerkNet 2.1 Upgrade: New Features and New Functions

ClerkNet, which allows the Clerk of the Court to provide users with a secure, searchable court document database via the Internet, will roll out ***ClerkNet 2.1*** in November 2009.

ClerkNet 2.1 is loaded with a new series of features and functions, which benefit both attorney-users and the Clerk's office. Some of the features of the upgrade are:

- A feature that allows the Clerk to create security rules users, i.e. allowing attorneys of record to view images that are confidential to others;
- A function that allows the Clerk to offer Judges the ability to view sealed cases;
- Improving an attorney's ability to access the information they're looking for, with the most current case information displayed;
- Allowing parties that are affiliated with confidential cases the ability to view documents electronically, rather than waiting for the paper file;
- Replacing *Governet* in public access areas with the more advanced *ClerkNet 2.1*;
- Enhancing security through the use of complex passwords and account lock-outs;
- Tracking system changes to develop a log of corrections, updates and improvements.

ClerkNet 2.1, which supports the Supreme Court of Florida's Administrative Order AOSC07-49 (policy on electronic release of court records), works with the latest software technology . As of Oct. 1, there were over 1250 registered ClerkNet users.
